Early Help Offer

At Ladygrove Primary School and Nursery, we understand that family life can sometimes be difficult and challenging. From time to time there may be situations where you feel you need more help and support. At these times we can offer you what is known as our Early Help Offer.

Providing early help to our children and families, means we can be more effective in preventing problems. Early help means providing support as soon as a concern emerges, at any point of a child's life, from Nursery through to Year 6.

Early Help Assessments are completed when it has been identified that a family requires support from school or external agencies. The assessment is evidence based and solution focused, to identify positive changes needed for the family.

These are a way of bringing all services together in a multi-agency approach to support the family, and ensure continued support for the child and family.

Meet the Pastoral Team



Miss Piper (Pastoral Lead)

Miss Piper is a qualified Emotional Literacy Support Assistant (ELSA) and she runs nurture and ELSA sessions in our Pastoral Pod. Miss Piper will also be able to support you with any SEND or home queries as she works closely with our SENDCo and Pupil & Family Support Worker.



Miss Barton (Pupil & Family Support Worker/Attendance Lead)

Miss Barton will be able to offer emotional and practical support to parents, carers and families, in your own homes and in the community. She supports you through the Early Help process and works with both children and families to improve attendance and punctuality.



Miss Ellis (SENDCo)

Miss Ellis is responsible for working closely with pupils, staff, agencies, and parents/carers to support them with any queries or requests that they may have in relation to SEND. Miss Ellis oversees the SEND provision across school and nursery.

The Pastoral Pod

At Ladygrove we have a dedicated therapeutic space for our mental health and wellbeing interventions where children will feel relaxed and comfortable. The environment has been specially designed to be welcoming and safe to support our children in developing their self esteem and greater understanding of their emotions.

Focused pastoral support for social, emotional and low-level mental health needs can be accessed in school through our Pastoral and Wellbeing Lead.

We can support children in areas such as mental wellbeing, friendships, family life, bereavement and behaviour, to understand their emotions and respect the feelings of those around them. This helps to build children's emotional resilience, which helps them to cope with life's challenges.

We have three fully trained ELSA's (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) Miss Piper, Miss Ward & Mrs Pennant.
